responsibilities and benefits:

A part to play in it's success. To contribute to the success of the enterprise, as a patron of, or supplier to, the Co-operative, according to my need or capability.

Efficiency and value for money. Working relationships between members of the co-operative will eventuate in elegantly planned provision of goods and services to members in the medium and long term.

Matching demand and supply. Established or fresh productive capacity may be applied to meet patrons' requirements, as stated in their 'wish lists,' which may in turn be adjusted as patrons become more aware of the productive capacity and capabilities within the co-operative.

Access to hire items from a library, a pool of tools, workshop time, machinery and transportation at Co-operative friendly rates.

"Special offers!" 'First dibs' opportunities to purchase occasional pieces made by producers purely to develop their practice or craft.

Advance notification of courses and events that the producer members intend to host.

Nurturing craft culture: A producer may accommodate an intern, enthusiast or understudy. A patron may be able to provide a “roof” for some materials or productive capacity.

A “say and a share.” The right to vote on how the Co-operative is run, including how any surpluses are allocated, for example to develop the co-operative, set up reserves, benefit members in proportion to their transactions with the co-operative (that’s a share in the profits,) and other activities approved by the members.

Best of all and arguably worth the subscription alone: Two tickets to the annual “Best of all” bash.

I agree to pay an **annual subscription of two hundred dollars** for a ‘five year plan’ membership commencing from the beginning of the next April to March financial year.
